

The first port of call for any employee/employment-related enquiry. The WR helpline can answer the vast majority of questions related to employee management and compliance with the Fair Work Act. This includes Modern Award interpretation, wage rates, leave entitlements, allowances and straightforward performance management or redundancy-related enquiries. For more complex matters your enquiry will be escalated to TCCI workplace relations consultants for further assistance.

TCCI workplace relations consultants provide advice and assistance in relation to more complex employee management and HR issues including, performance management, investigations, enterprise agreement negotiations, redundancy and restructure. Our consultants can also assist with policy review and development, employment contract preparation and development of induction and/or performance management processes.

Depending on your membership level there may be a cost to utilise this service which you will be advised of prior to work being undertaken.

HR BUSINESS PARTNER

This is a retainer-based service that provides HR and workplace relations support to your business and has been designed for small to medium businesses that do not have a dedicated HR resource. HR business partner arrangements are negotiated over a 12-month period based on business needs and budget. HR business partner provides access to both the workplace relations helpline and workplace relations consultancy services packaged into a monthly fee.

TCCI WORKPLACE

This platform provides practical HR management for your business and includes legally checked employment documents, checklists, policies and forms. TCCI members can access an annual online subscription at the preferred member rate of \$1600.

All documents can be customised to your business needs and you will receive notifications when documents need to be updated or reviewed.

TCCI ADVOCACY - A VOICE FOR BUSINESS IN TASMANIA

TCCI advocates to all levels of government on issues impacting business in Tasmania. If you have a particular issue you want us to be aware of, please contact us.

Through our relationship with the Australian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (ACCI) TCCI can effectively advocate the views of Tasmanian business at a national level.

Through the Tasmanian Chamber Alliance, TCCI keeps informed of issues affecting business in regional Tasmania.

TCCI POLICY COMMITTEE

TCCI established a Policy Committee in 2022. This Committee meets regularly to discuss key policy areas and where appropriate formulate responses to government and/or policy positions.

Through the Policy Committee TCCI instigated bi-annual Industry Summits, where heads of key industry bodies and other stakeholders share information on issues impacting specific industries to achieve better outcomes for Tasmanian business.

BUSINESS UPDATES

Take the hassle out of keeping up to date with changes affecting business. TCCI business updates provide information to business in Tasmania regarding changes affecting business and other relevant news and information. Common topics for updates include:

WHS DIAGNOSTIC

Not sure where you are at in relation to WHS in your workplace? Undertaking a WHS diagnostic is a great starting point to understand what you are doing well and any areas that might need some attention. Following the completion of the diagnostic questionnaire, you will receive a report with recommendations. We can provide you with policy documents and templates to help implement recommendations from the diagnostic report.

SITE VISITS

Our TCCI WHS Facilitators can attend your worksite and complete a workplace checklist making recommendations for improvements where appropriate.

We can also come to your workplace and present to management, staff or at toolbox meetings on WHS related topics.

CUSTOMISED TRAINING

Depending on your needs, the WHS service can customise a WHS training session to your workplace practices, policies and requirements.

WHS BUSINESS BRIEFINGS

These sessions usually include an expert guest speaker providing business relevant information on contemporary WHS issues and topics. Most sessions have the opportunity for questions.











TRADE DOCUMENTATION SERVICES - CERTIFICATES OF ORIGIN

TCCI, through delegation from the Australian Chamber of Commerce and Industry, is authorised by the Australian Government to issue Certificates of Origin for Australian businesses both for ordinary trade and for Australia's Free Trade Agreements.

Certificates of Origin are documents used in international trade for millions of transactions around the globe every year certifying the status of goods traded across borders.

TCCI partners with essCert to provide exporters and freight forwarders with a user-friendly, online solution that enables them to process Certificates of Origin with our chamber direct from their desktops.

TCCI members receive preferential rates on Certificates of Origin. Our website provides detailed information and instructions to register as an exporter.

Manual signing of Certificates of Origin and other trade documentation is available on request. Contact us by phone or email to arrange.

TRAINING ROOM HIRE
