

## **Chamber Change: Small Business FAQs**

### **What is Chamber Change: Small Business?**

Chamber Change: Small Business is a national leadership and empowerment program for aspiring and current female small business owners.

It is delivered by Tasmanian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (TCCI) in partnership with the Australian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (ACCI) and the Victorian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (VCCI), with support from the Federal Government.

### **Who can apply?**

Women who:

- Are planning to start a small business, or
- Currently own or manage a small business, and
- Want to build leadership, confidence and business skills.

No previous leadership program experience is required - just a willingness to learn, connect and grow!

### **What does the program involve?**

Participants will attend three in-person sessions over three months, each including:

- Leadership presentations from senior female business leaders (Champions)
- Networking opportunities and workshops
- Presenting with Purpose coaching
- Official Chamber Change accreditation on completion

Each session runs for approximately three hours and includes a networking lunch.

### **When and where will the program run?**

The program will run between October 2025 and November 2025 at Aura Hobart.

Specific dates and session details will be confirmed once Expressions of Interest close.

### **What is the cost to participate?**

Thanks to Federal Government funding, participation is fully subsidised - meaning there is no cost to attend the program.
